The ceremony unfolds on the *Motu Iti*, in the middle of the lagoonarium.

Duration: 40 minutes.

The couple is dressed with traditional Tahitian costumes in their room. The groom rides to the *motu* on a traditional outrigger canoe while dancers lead the bride from the room to the *motu* where the ceremony takes place.

The couple is greeted to the sound of the *Pu*, songs and *ukuleles*, and is escorted to the altar where the priest awaits them. With a blend of Polynesian tradition and wedding symbols, the master of ceremonies conducts the couple's union. He provides flower necklaces and crowns, and the couple exchanges these flowers as a symbol of their vows. They are then baptized with their Polynesian names and given a wedding certificate.

Upon leaving the *motu*, dancers wrap the couple with a traditional *Tifaifai* (Polynesian wedding quilt) and close the ceremony with a dance show celebrating the couple's happiness while they enjoy a *Maitai* cocktail served in a coconut shell. The couple is then escorted to their room, where a bottle of Champagne is awaiting them.







THE CEREMONY INCLUDES:

- Supervision of the Wedding Coordinator
- Priest
- Polynesian trio and 8 dancers
- Flower decoration
- Traditional costumes
- Three pareos to dress the couple
- Two flower necklaces and crowns
- Bride's bouquet
- Two Tahitian punches served in a coconut shell
- Wedding certificate made of *Tapa*
- One bottle of Champagne





The ceremony takes place on the main *motu*, on its natural stage facing the sister island Moorea Duration : 60 minutes.

The couple is dressed in the privacy of their room and is invited to dress in white pareos, the traditional wedding outfit in French Polynesia. The groom rides to the *motu* on a traditional outrigger canoe, while dancers escort the bride from the room to the *motu* where the ceremony takes place.

The couple is greeted to the sound of the *pu*, songs and *ukuleles*, and is escorted to the altar where the priest awaits them. The priest conducts the couple's union following Polynesian tradition, speaking in Tahitian. He provides flower necklaces and crowns, and the couple exchanges these flowers as a symbol of their vows. The priest joins the couple's hands with an *Auti* leaf and blesses them by pouring coconut water. He then baptizes them with their Polynesian names.

They are introduced to Tahitian dance and wrapped in the traditional *Tifaifai* which symbolizes their union. The couple is then escorted to their room, where a bottle of Champagne and a wedding cake are awaiting them.

- Priest
- Polynesian trio and 14 dancers
- Flower decoration
- Traditional costumes
- Three pareos to dress the couple
- Two flower necklaces and crowns
- Bride's bouquet
- Two Tahitian punches served in a coconut shell
- Wedding certificate made in *Tapa*
- One bottle of Champagne
- A wedding cake





The ceremony takes place on the Lotus' small *motu*. Duration: 15 minutes.

The couple is dressed in the privacy of their room with white pareos. They are then accompanied to the place of the ceremony by the coordinator, where they are greeted by the Priest and a local musician.

According to Polynesian tradition, the Priest proceeds with the renewal of vows ceremony. The couple will exchange flower necklaces and crowns and the Priest will baptize them with their Polynesian names.

The couple is wrapped with the traditional *Tifaifai*, and receives the final blessing of the Priest to the sound of *ukulele*.







THE CEREMONY INCLUDES:

- Master of Ceremony (Polynesian Priest)
- One local musician
- Pareos to dress the couple, if the bride and groom have their own clothes, the pareos will be given to them as a gift
- Two flower necklaces and crowns
- Bride's bouquet
- Wedding certificate made of *Tapa*


